

GCSE RESULTS 2020

Highlights

Our year 11

41 pupils in Y11 (2019 39) (25 boys, 16 girls)

234 GCSE entries – Average 5.7 GCSEs per pupil (2019 – 5)

9 (24%) students attended TMBSS for the whole of KS4 (27% 2019)

32 students (78%) joined us in KS4 (73% 2018)

10 (24%) students joined TMBSS in Y10

22 (54%) joined us in Y11 (65% 2019) of which 16 arrived for the start of Y11, 4 joined in the Autumn term, 2 in the spring term.

Average number of terms pupils were with us is 3.5. (2019 3.25)
